

Joint Use Agreement Review

Communiqué #6

April 28, 2005

The Joint Use Agreement (JUA) partners (City of Edmonton, Edmonton Catholic School Board and Edmonton Public School Board) review team held its sixth meeting April 28, 2005 to continue discussions and designing of the new JUA agreement.

As the JUA Review Team discusses issues, the understandings and areas of consensus are being documented in a Memorandum of Understanding for the Partnering Organizations. These understandings and commitments will later be transcribed and reflected in the new JUA. This document is updated as the partners reach consensus on issues, and other components of the JUA are being developed.

The JUA Review Team brainstormed ten potential "models" for Joint Use. A Matrix identifying the models and their previously established evaluative criteria will be circulated to JUA Review Team this week so all Partners can assess the various models to decide on a model which will best meet the needs of the JUA in serving the citizens of Edmonton.

The JUA Review Team reaffirmed that they are determined and committed to completing a thorough review process. The Partner's perspectives are the quality and completeness of the review is the priority. The JUA Review Team Partners confirmed that the current agreement would remain in place until the new JUA document is complete.

The JUA Review Team is currently working on communication and an information package to provide to the Steering Committee and Sub Committees in June.

Collectively the JUA Review Team will continue to provide regular updates on progress as the Partnering Organizations work through the review process to create a new JUA that is reflective of current needs for all partnering organizations.
