

# Summary of Class Sizes for Regular Programs

in Edmonton Catholic Schools  
2003-2004

## Notes:

- "Class size" refers to the number of students organized in either a homeroom or by subject
- Special education programs are excluded in the average class size report
- A student may be in a similar size class throughout elementary, as the class moves from grade to grade

## Did you know?

- class sizes decreased in Grades 2/3, 3, 3/4, 6, 7, 8, and 9
- average class sizes in Grades 1-6 (average of 23.8) are at par with the provincial average of 23.2 (as of 2002)
- 84% of classes in Grade 1 are at 25 students or less
- 72% of classes in Grade 2 are at 25 students or less
- 74% of classes in Grade 3 are at 25 students or less
- 84% of classes in upper elementary are at 28 students or less
- 76% of Kindergarten classes are at 23 students or less
- Kindergarten average increased to 20.3 from 19.2
- average class size in Grades 7-9 is 26.6, a decrease of .9 from last year
- 88.2% of junior high classes have 30 or less students, an increase of 2.2% from last year
- 72.2% of combined 3 and 5 credit courses in senior high have enrolments of 30 students or less in Grade 10; 76.5% in Grade 11; and 81.0% in Grade 12
- average combined class size from Grades 1/2 to Grades 5/6 is 23.38
- only 8.7% of all classes in the elementary program (Grades K-6) are combined classes for a total of 60 classes
- all combined classes have a minimum .4 FTE teacher assistant (Grades 1-6)
