**CSI Senior High
Photo and interview opportunities from 1:15 to 2:15 p.m.
Thursday, December 9**

The second annual, Senior High CSI Cup will take place on Thursday, December 9. Approximately 60 students from Archbishop O'Leary and Austin O'Brien Catholic High Schools will take part in a day of tours/demonstrations, and competition. The afternoon features a CSI competition at the Grant MacEwan Community College South Campus in Millwoods (7319 – 29 Ave.). Students will test their investigative skills while uncovering crime scene evidence in a mock murder investigation.

Morning activities at police headquarters will include; a firearms presentation at the indoor range, an officer safety demonstration in the gym and a high-risk vehicle stop simulation.

At the culmination of the day, the teams' responses will be evaluated and students from the "winning" team will be awarded a trophy they can take back to school with them. Due to the expansion of the CSI program, the Edmonton Catholic School District and the Edmonton Police Service have partnered with Grant MacEwan College in order to accommodate the increasing number of students.

This is the only program of its kind in Canada and is intended to affect school culture by helping to build good relationships between students, schools, and the EPS. The program will also provide a better understanding of the role of police officers for students who would like to pursue a career in law enforcement.
