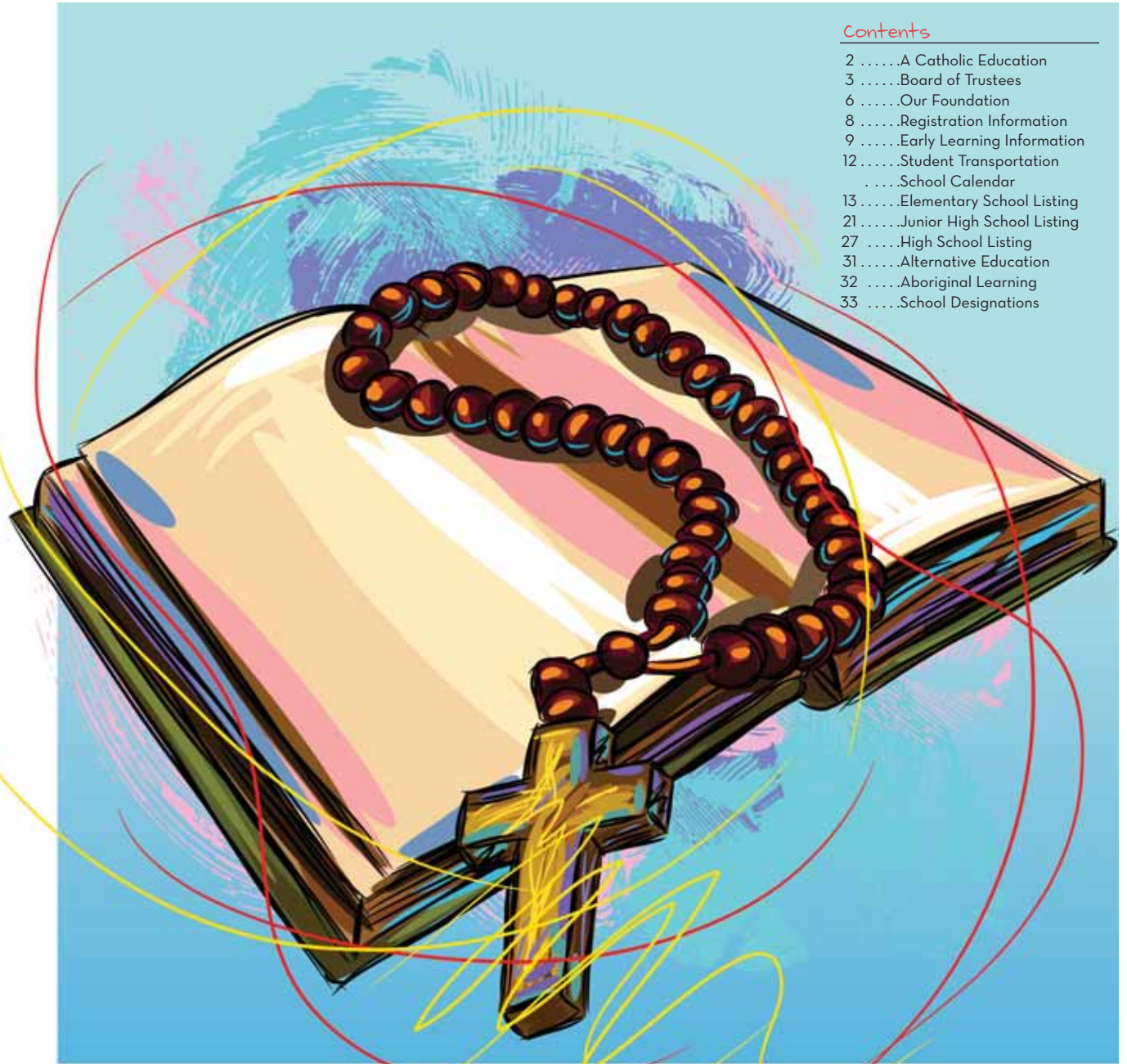

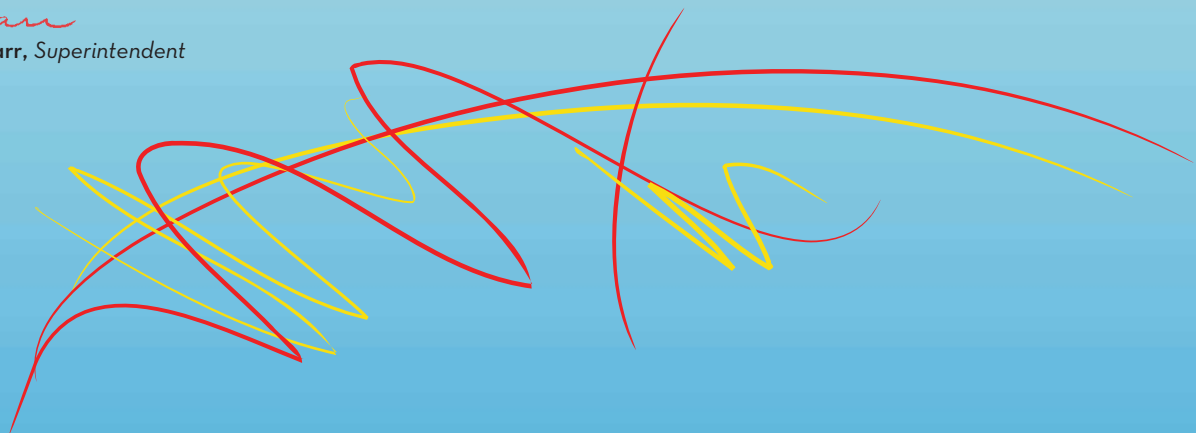

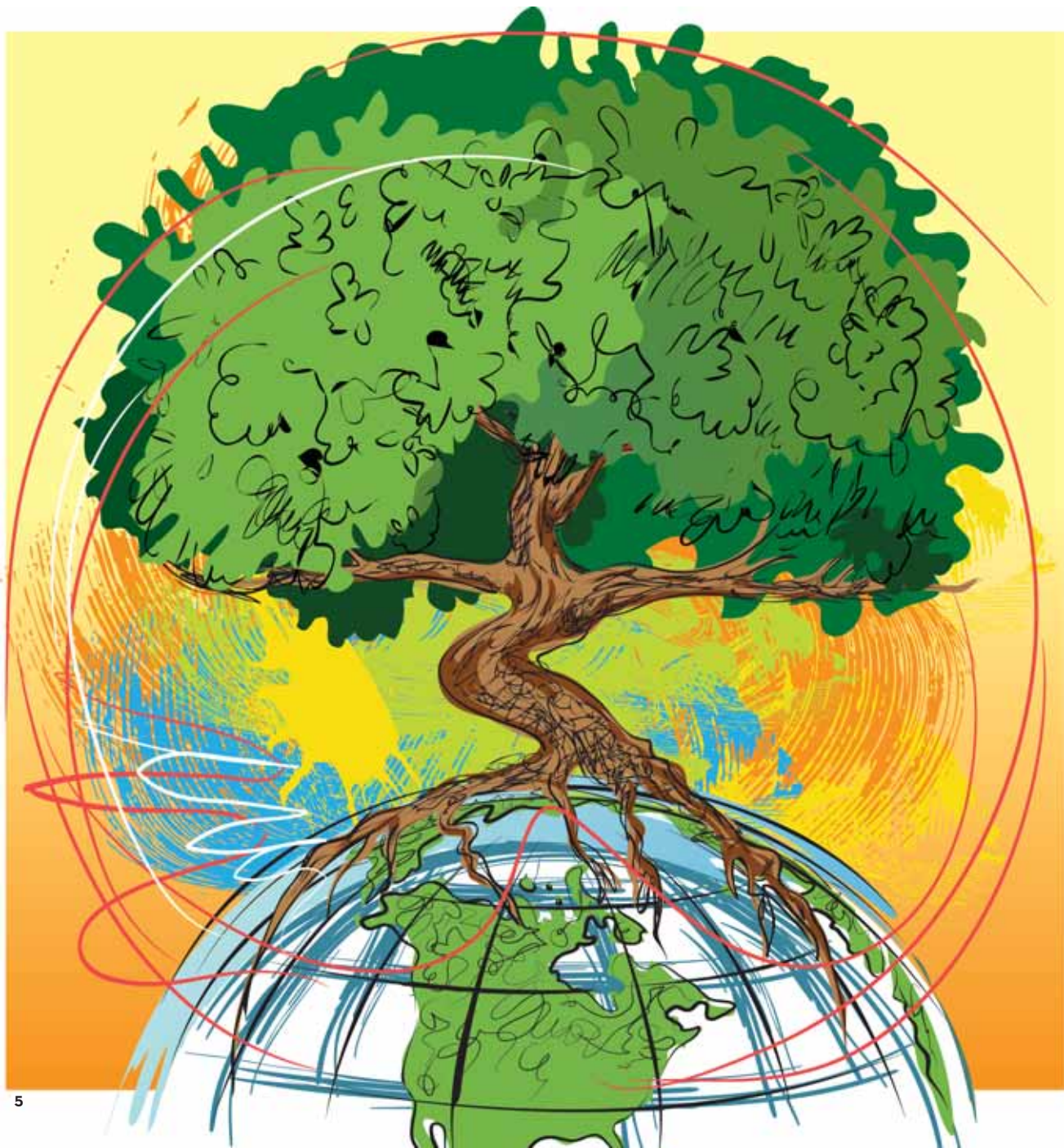

School Boundaries or “Catchment Areas”

Edmonton Catholic Schools features an open boundary system. Therefore, students are free to enroll at the school of their choice, given adequate availability of resources and a suitable educational program. Please note that each geographic region within the City of Edmonton is associated with designated feeder schools. Resident students within a particular “catchment area” or school boundary are entitled to attend specific feeder schools. (See pages 33-34 for more information about feeder schools).

EARLY LEARNING REGISTRATION

Entering Pre-K/Kindergarten is an exciting time for your child and an important first step in their Catholic education. We want this transition to be as smooth as possible for you and your child. Each school has an orientation process for your child and will provide further information when you visit and/or register.

The following is a list of commonly asked questions:

How old must my child be to register for an Early Learning program?

Kindergarten programming occurs in all of our elementary schools.

- To be eligible for Kindergarten your child must be five years old on or before March 1 of the school year that they would be starting Kindergarten. All elementary schools provide a Kindergarten program.

100 Voices is a pre-Kindergarten program.

- Many of our schools offer 100 Voices with some of those schools offering both three year old and four year old programming. Where 100 Voices is offered for both three and four year olds, programming is typically mixed with natural communities of three year old and four year old children grouped together.
- To be eligible for the year prior to Kindergarten, your child must be four years old on or before March 1 of the school year. Fees may apply.
- To be eligible for two years prior to Kindergarten, your child should be three years of age and toilet trained by September 30 of the current school year. Special consideration may be provided to children identified with special needs. Fees may apply.
- For further information on 100 Voices programs please contact the school offering the Pre-K program or Genesis; Early Learning Centre at 780 638-6810.

Pre-School Outreach

- Preschool Outreach is educational programming that occurs in select daycares in our schools, as well as some select YMCA sites located outside of our schools.
- To be eligible for Preschool Outreach your child must be three years of age by September 30 or four years of age by March 1 of the school year and qualify for special needs and/or ESL funding. For further information please contact the school daycare or YMCA site, or Genesis; Early Learning Centre at 780 638-6810.

How do I find out about a Pre-K/Kindergarten program?

For additional information contact individual schools, Catholic Education Services at 780 441-6000 or our Genesis Early Learning Centre at 780 638-6810. You can also visit our website at www.ecsd.net. Be sure to also participate in the screening/intake process offered at each site if you are registering in a Pre-K program.

What kind of documentation do I need to register my child?

You will be asked to provide proof of your child's name, date of birth and citizenship.

Only the following documents verifying birth are accepted:

- Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate, Canadian Citizen Certificate or Passport

There are many ways that you can make the transition to school go smoothly for your child:

- Talk often about Pre-K/Kindergarten and reassure your child that it will be an exciting experience.
- Attend the Pre-K/Kindergarten Open House at your child's school in the spring.
- Find out when your child can meet his/her teacher and have a tour of the classroom before school begins in the fall.
- Help your child develop a sense of responsibility. Encourage your child to learn to look after his/her belongings.
- Read with your child daily and have conversations about the books.
- Explore the world in which your child lives. Talk about what your child sees by pointing out signs, numbers and letters.
- Provide opportunities for your child to interact with other children in order to promote the development of social skills.
- Encourage your child to know his/her personal information (i.e. first and last name and phone number).
- Together celebrate the little accomplishments that occur each day.
- Pray together.

What should I tell the teacher about my child?

The Early Learning teacher and the school will want as much information as possible. For example:

- How does your child feel about coming to school?
- Has your child been in pre-school or daycare or will this be his/her first experience away from home?
- What are your child's special passions or interests?
- What are your child's special needs? (This includes everything: allergies, fears, unique physical or medical conditions, previous speech and language intervention, emotional or behavioural patterns, or any major change that might be occurring in your child's life).

What will my child learn in Early Learning?

In addition to the teacher, Alberta Education is a great resource and publishes, 'Kindergarten in Alberta - A Handbook for Parents-Catholic Version.' The resource is available at the Alberta Education website <http://education.alberta.ca/parents/ecs.aspx> or you can ask the school to see a copy during orientation. It is a very valuable resource.

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

Edmonton Catholic Schools contracts various carriers to provide service to approximately 15,000 students every school day. Transportation includes Edmonton Transit Service, charter (yellow) bus service, special needs charter (yellow) bus service and noon hour charter (yellow) bus service. Transportation services are provided within specific geographic regions or “catchment areas,” according to a system of school designation that is based on the student’s home address. The Mountain Cree Camp School - Kisiko Awasis Kiskinhamawin

- The Mountain Cree Camp (more commonly known in the past as the Smallboy Camp) was established in 1968 by Chief Smallboy and some members from the Erminskin Band. The Erminskin Band is part of the four bands that make up the reserves in Maskwaches, also

known as Hobbema. The first camp was established on the Kootenay Plains, in the foothills near Nordegg. Their intent was to establish a community that would be guided by many of the traditional Cree practices and beliefs. In 1971, the camp relocated to Muskiki Lake near Robb, a location they occupy today. In the

spring of 2009, Alberta Education reached an agreement with Edmonton Catholic School District #7 to operate Kisiko Awasis for a two school-year period. In the spring of 2011, Alberta Education and Edmonton Catholic School District #7 agreed to a two year extension on this arrangement.
