




1. *The Edmonton Catholic Separate School District No. 7 recognizes its Catholic Christian obligation to the wise stewardship of all resources.*
2. *All schools must be physically capable of meeting the demands of the educational programs being offered therein.*
3. *In order to educate students in an atmosphere permeated by faith and religious values, Edmonton Catholic Separate School District No. 7 shall not support the design and construction of schools in which students in the district share educational space with students not registered in district schools.*
4. *Consultation and cooperation with municipal, community and other educational authorities are encouraged in order to achieve more effective use of all district facilities.*
5. *Joint development and joint ownership of school/park sites with the municipalities served by the district are favoured wherever such a plan is advantageous to the district.*
6. *Leasing and rentals must be congruent with the values of the district. The district may permit the use of district facilities by community groups provided there is no conflict with the operation of any school and no unreasonable costs are incurred.*
7. *The primary purpose of the district facilities in the Edmonton Catholic Separate School District No. 7 is to further the education of the children who reside in the system.*

**Definition:**

**District facilities** include schools, buildings other than school buildings, grounds, equipment, furniture, and materials.
