




Where a decision of an employee of the Board significantly affects the education of a student, the student or parent may appeal that decision to the Superintendent of Schools (or designate as identified by the Superintendent) who acts on behalf of the Board.

After hearing the appeal, the person designated to hear the appeal may decide whether the subject matter of the appeal is a decision of a Board employee which significantly affects the education of a student.
