




The Edmonton Catholic Separate School District No. 7 shall provide a safe and healthy environment for its entire community and for the activities by students, staff, and guests and shall comply with all legislated requirements including the Alberta Occupational Health and Safety Act, and other federal or provincial regulations pertaining to occupational and environmental safety.

All District employees have a duty to foster a concern for the health and safety of all students, fellow employees, and guests and to comply with statutory requirements and established work procedures or practices and to report unsafe or unhealthy conditions to their supervisors.

The District shall establish and support a joint occupational health, safety and environment committee comprised of balanced representation from both administration and employees to ensure that all parties can genuinely and positively influence these processes.
