




Fourth Year High School Students

Administrative Regulation 103.2

1. Under most circumstances, students are expected to complete high school within an equivalent of six semesters.
2. Evidence of working to meet this expectation includes realistic program planning, including a minimum credit enrolment per semester, regular attendance, and successful completion of courses.
3. In order to support those students who have not achieved a high school diploma within this normal time period or those who wish to return to upgrade, Edmonton Catholic Separate School District No. 7 will provide an alternative program designed to serve the needs of fourth year high school students.
4. Effective September 2000 all returning grade twelve students within the City of Edmonton will be directed to this program. Principals are to ensure those students and parents are informed.
5. Students may be exempted from this requirement for any of the following reasons:
 - a. prolonged absences from school due to illness;
 - b. program requirements that cannot be served in an alternate schools (e.g. special Education, ESL, etc.); and
 - c. enrolment in a program necessitating an extension past the regular six semester term.
