




**Recommendation for a
Permanent Professional
Teaching Certificate or a
Continuous Contract**
Administrative Regulation 207.5

1. A recommendation by the superintendent or designate that a teacher be issued a permanent professional certificate shall be supported by
 - a. The results of two or more evaluations of the teacher’s performance, and
 - b. a statement by the superintendent or designate that the teacher
 - i. consistently uses the knowledge, skills and attributes specified under the *Alberta Education Policy 4.2.1 (Ministerial Order #016/97)* in ways that help students learn;
 - ii. consistently demonstrates sound professional judgement in all matters related to teaching; and
 - iii. has demonstrated significant professional growth.

2. A recommendation by the superintendent or designate that a teacher be offered employment under a continuous contract shall be supported by
 - a. The results of one or more evaluations of the teacher’s performance, and
 - b. a statement by the principal that
 - i. the teacher consistently meets the Standards of Teaching Practice; and
 - ii. recommends that the teacher receive a continuous contract.
