


Disciplinary Action



EDMONTON CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Administrative Regulation 207.8

1. Notwithstanding the supervision and evaluation procedures as described in this policy and these regulations
 - a. the superintendent or principal may take disciplinary or other action as appropriate where there are reasonable grounds for believing that the actions or practices of a teacher endanger the safety of students or constitute a neglect of duty, a breach of trust, or a refusal to obey a lawful order of the district;
 - b. the superintendent may suspend or terminate a teacher from the performance of duties under the provisions of the *School Act*.
2. Where a teacher is suspended or terminated, provisions under the appropriate legislation or district policy shall apply.
