


Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education

Administrative Regulation 307

1. Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education Services offer outreach and alternative programs that meet the needs of the community by providing learning and growth opportunities not provided by other district programs.
2. Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education Services may organize delivery of its programs in a variety of ways including the forming of community partnerships.
3. Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education Services may enter into partnership agreements with community members and community facilities. All partnerships formed with the greater community are to keep within the mission of the Edmonton Catholic Separate School District No. 7.
4. All Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education Programs are to operate within the provisions of the *School Act* and the regulations of Alberta Education.
5. All credit courses are to be taught by certificated teachers employed by the Edmonton Catholic Separate School District No. 7.
6. The assistant superintendent of Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education Services, in cooperation with local schools, will determine facility and equipment requirements for the programs. The needs of this service take priority over external users with respect to school use.
7. Planning for the accommodation of Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education Services shall be included in the district plan for the location of programs.
8. Lifelong Learning and Alternative Education Services are to operate on a cost recovery basis. Any surpluses may be used to expand district programs.
