Fresh Start offers:

- ➔ all courses/subjects available
* subject to minimum enrollment
- ➔ course material is designed for independent work but teachers are available at the site at all times to work with students on a one-on-one basis
- ➔ self-paced learning
- ➔ accelerate your pace by working on or off site
- ➔ flexible scheduling, including long weekends, (see schedule on the next panel) can be accommodated. The lead teacher at each site can help you work out arrangements if you let them know ahead of time!
- ➔ completion of modules is scheduled to ensure you're on track for success. Due dates for the modules will be set by the teachers
- ➔ the department recommends that students wishing to take a 30 level core course for the first time register in the classroom instructed sessions at one of the four high schools.

ATTENDANCE / WORKLOAD

Each week of summer school is the equivalent of more than one month in a semestered high school. Full attendance is crucial. Students will not be allowed to start at a later date or write final exams early to accommodate holiday plans! High school credit courses are compressed into a short time period. Students must be prepared to spend 2 to 3 hours per day on studies beyond class time.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students in Canada on a valid Student Visa/Authorization are eligible to attend the summer school credit program. You must apply in person (an appointment is necessary) and bring your current visa, passport, school records for review to determine eligibility for admission.

DIPLOMA EXAMINATIONS

* All diploma exams for registered summer school students will be written at Archbishop O’Leary High School (8760 – 132 Avenue). The fee for rewriting a diploma exam is \$26.75 (includes GST) payable to Alberta Learning. We are NOT a “walk-in” writing centre. Rewrite forms will be available at your site. Be sure to check the deadline date on the form.

* International students registering in a diploma course are required to pay an additional \$50.00 sitting fee for the diploma exam (payable at registration time)!

* All students writing diploma exams MUST present an acceptable picture ID (Student ID or drivers’ license)!
