Re: Edmonton Catholic Schools Accountability Pillar Report October 2014

Alberta Education provides all school jurisdictions in Alberta with Accountability Pillar Reports in October and May of each year. The October 2014 report (Attachment #1) carries forward results for the measures of *High School Completion, Drop Out Rate, Post-Secondary Transition Rate, and Rutherford Scholarship Eligibility Rate* from the May 2014 report. All provincial teacher, parent and student survey results are carried forward as well. These include the measures: *Safe and Caring Schools, Program of Studies, Work Preparation, Citizenship, Parental Involvement and School Improvement*. Provincial Achievement Test and Diploma results are all updated from the previous October 2013 report.

Overall Measure Evaluation

The Overall Measure Evaluation combines the Achievement and Improvement measure evaluations for an overall measure evaluation.

None of the measures are rated as an Issue or Concern.
