High District Satisfaction Survey Results

The 2016/17 District Satisfaction Survey shows continued high satisfaction in numerous categories. Over 37,000 students, staff and parents responded to the survey that took place November 1st – 18th, 2016. A paper survey was used for students and staff which compares with online surveys in the past. Parents continued to receive a paper format for the survey.

“Overall response rates increased with all groups in comparison to last year, with Grade 10 – 12 student responses increasing by 19%,” said Joan Carr, Superintendent. “While online surveys have also been effective, we feel that the paper format was instrumental to the positive results we received, added Carr.
