- Leadership activities (5 points)

- Hobbies/Personal (5 points)

- Activities 3 @ 5 points= (15 points)

- Questions 2 @ 10 points = (20 points)

- 2 confidential recommendations (10 points each) – Only one School Letter of Recommendation

Scholarships of \$ 1,000 each will be funded by City of Champions Lions Club, Only 1 award per student will be awarded regardless of number of applications received. Meaning the student can only receive one award from The CITY OF CHAMPIONS LIONS CLUB. But students are eligible to apply for all available scholarships.
