Student Learning Accountability Report

1. October 2019 Accountability Pillar Report

Alberta Education provides all school jurisdictions in Alberta with Accountability Pillar reports in October and May of each school year. In the attached October 2019 report, the Provincial Achievement Test and Diploma Examination standards results have been updated from the previously released May 2019 report.

The May 2019 report included updates of the following 12 measures: Safe and Caring Schools, Program of Studies, Education Quality, Drop-Out Rate, High School Completion Rate, Diploma Exam Participation Rate, Rutherford Scholarship Eligibility Rate, Post-Secondary Transition Rate, Work Preparation, Citizenship, Parental Involvement, and School Improvement.

Accountability Pillar measures are combined into seven categories which track a school jurisdiction's progress towards reaching their education goals. Each category consists of measures evaluated on both achievement (comparison against fixed provincial standards) and improvement (comparison against previous performance). An overall evaluation for each measure is made by combining both the achievement and improvement results.

Category: Safe and Caring Schools

(results previously released in the May 2019 report)

Success in this category is determined through this measure:

 Safe and Caring - Teachers, parents, and students agree that students are safe at school, are learning the importance of caring for others, are learning respect for others, and are treated fairly at school.


High School Completion Rate (3 year) - The percentage of students in the Grade 10 cohort who have completed high school by the end of their third year, adjusted for attrition. Students who move from one school authority to another during high school are attributed to the school authority where they received the most credits. An adjustment for attrition (outmigration, mortality) is applied based on estimates from Statistics Canada.





- The percentage of Edmonton Catholic Schools' students achieving the **Acceptable Standard exceeded** the provincial percentage of students in **13 out of 14 standards**.



- Grade 6 students exceeded the provincial percentage of students achieving the Acceptable Standard in ALL subject areas (100%).
- Grade 9 students exceeded the provincial percentage of students achieving the Acceptable Standard in ALL subject areas (100%).
- Grade 9 K&E students exceeded the provincial percentage of students achieving the Acceptable Standard in English Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies.





Overall, Edmonton Catholic Schools' students continue to be successful in diploma courses.

Diploma exams are worth 30% and the school-awarded mark is worth 70% of the overall diploma course marks for students.
