Practicing Self Care

What are a few things you could do this month to help care and nourish yourself? Strive for progress, not perfection. Try integrating one or two of these ideas into your month. It's about making small, sustainable changes.

WORKPLACE SELF-CARE

- Tackle a piece of technology you're struggling with
- Attend professional development opportunities
- Determine what work/life balance means to you and aim for that

PSYCHOLOGICAL SELF-CARE

- Activities that help you to feel clear-headed and able to intellectually engage with the challenges that are found in your work and personal life.
- Be curious and try something new that interests you - it could lead to a potential new hobby
- Turn off your email and work phone outside of work hours
- Make time to simply unwind
- Focus on practicing gratitude;
 it can help shift perspective

EMOTIONAL SELF-CARE

- Allowing yourself to safely experience your full range of emotions.
- Spend some time identifying the major stressors in your life, and how you might tackle them head on
- Talk to a friend about how you are coping with work and life demands
- Schedule an appointment with a therapist or counsellor

PHYSICAL SELF-CARE

- Go for a walk, run, hike, workout or play a sport
- Consider ways to get a better night's sleep, and develop your own sleep routine
- Create a MyHealth Records account to easily access your personal information through Alberta Health Services
- Schedule the doctor's appointment you've been putting off

RELATIONSHIP SELF-CARE

- This is about maintaining healthy, supportive relationships, and ensuring you have diversity in your relationships.
- Prioritize close relationships in your life e.g., with partners, family, and children
- Attend the special events of your family and friends, even if its a Zoom event

FINANCIAL SELF-CARE

- Take a free financial literacy course and get a handle on the lingo
- Look at your bank statement and reflect on where you might be overspending
- Set a small goals, work at savings and/or investments
