

- 1. If you live in Second/Rosenthal, are in Grade 5 to 9, and currently attend BDM, you DO NOT have to change schools, however busing will not be provided. Your sibling may also attend BDM with you.
- 2.St. Josephine Bakhita will offer an Out-of-School Roll-Away Program for students in Grades 1 to 6 when it opens in September 2025. Additional details will be shared in Spring 2025.
- 3. Yellow bus transportation to St. Josephine Bakhita will be available for eligible students. More information will be provided in Spring 2025.

Respondents were asked to provide feedback on the proposed attendance area for St. Josephine Bakhita School. These are the top three themes that emerged:

- 1. **Boundary was not big enough** (wanted to include the Big Lakes/Starling communities).
- 2. Concerns with grandfathering students living in Rosenthal/Secord who currently attend BDM and wish to stay there. Respondents feel BDM will still be overcrowded.
- 3. Wanted busing to St. Josephine Bakhita from Secord/Rosenthal communities.
