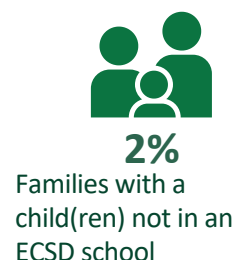
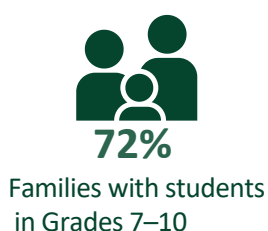

TOTAL SURVEY RESPONDENTS

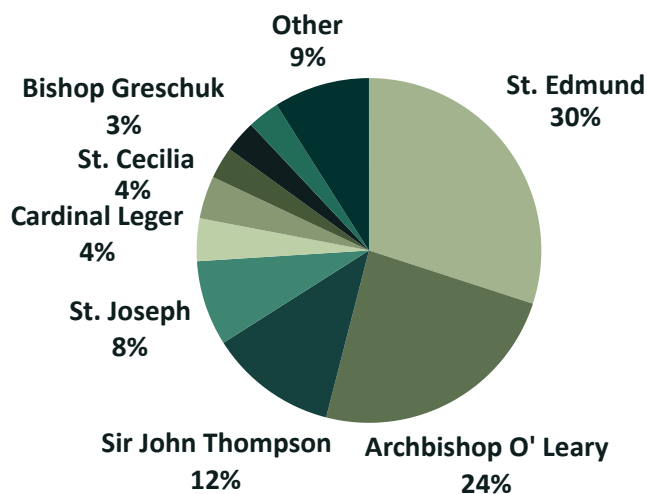
Edmonton Catholic Schools (ECSD) conducted an engagement questionnaire to gather feedback on the proposed attendance area and programming for St. Carlo Acutis Catholic High School, scheduled to open in September 2026. A total of 271 responses were received, primarily from families with children currently enrolled in ECSD schools.

SCHOOLS WHERE RESPONDENTS' CHILDREN ARE ENROLLED



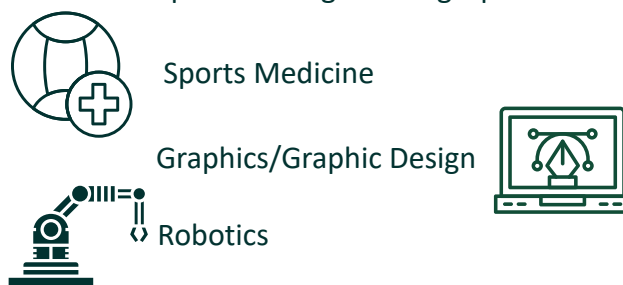
SCHOOLS RESPONDENTS' CHILDREN ATTEND

120 RESPONDENTS LIKE THE PROPOSED ATTENDANCE AREA

Respondents were asked to provide feedback on the proposed attendance area for St. Carlo Acutis. These are the top three themes that emerged:

1. Many respondents expressed interest in clear boundaries and feeder patterns
2. Boundary area and size concerns, proposed area was either too small or too large
3. Proximity and transportation concerns for the families east of the proposed area

NEXT STEPS

- Finalize attendance area and communicate feeder school alignment
- Review programming priorities to align with community interest
- Continue engagement as the school opening approaches to confirm offerings and address transportation considerations
