• Quality of Education: over 96% of parents satisfied

• Safety: over 97% of parents satisfied with safety

• Grades 4 to 6 students: over 96% happy with their school

Grades 7 to 9 students: over 90% satisfied with quality of education
 Grades 10 to 12 students: over 92% satisfied with quality of education
