

## ECSD - Current Situation

- In the last ten years Edmonton Catholic Schools has grown by 15,000 students, but new schools have only been able to accommodate half of this growth.
- In the Northwest Sector, where St. Lucy is located, the utilization for the entire sector is 90%.




## St. Lucy- Current Situation

- St. Lucy Catholic Elementary School has a high utilization 117%
- Enrolment continues to grow. Enrolment on September 29, 2023, was 397.
- Many students come from the newer neighbourhoods to the northwest including Oxford, Carlton and Rapperswill.




#### St Lucy

### ECSD Actions for 2023-24

- 1. All space has been allocated for instructional purposes and maximizing the capacity of the school
- 2. Requested two modulars from Alberta Government for installation Sept 2024 (increase capacity by 50)
- 3. Direct school administration to reduce the number of out-of-boundary students in the future
- 4. ECSD will continue monitoring St. Lucy as a VIP school



### **Next Steps**

- Addition of two new modulars to St. Lucy in 2024, pending Provincial approval.
- ECSD will continue to monitor St. Lucy as a VIP School in the 2024-25 school year.
- ECSD Board of Trustees continues to advocate for investment in new schools, replacement schools, and modernizations and will continue to work with the Alberta Government to ensure our students and families are served.
