10 WAYS TO USE CHAT EDITOR



During calendar, use it for the date, the weather and any special events.
At the beginning of the day, use it to go over the daily schedule.
Use SPELL/123, to type out spelling words or the agenda message.
For an art or science project, use it to talk about the materials your students need to get ready.
Use it to describe higher level vocabulary words. For example, chrysalis can be defined as IN CHANGE OUT DIFFERENT
Use it to describe the special student (e.g., GIRL, BLUE SHIRT, BROWN HAIR) and see if students can guess who it is before spelling their name on SPELL/123 page.
Model words during book reading (both from the text and to talk about the pictures).
Use the words on a page as part of the lesson. For example, which animals hibernate (from the COME page).
For a quick movement break, have students pick 4 action words from the GO or DO page that they will do for 15 seconds each.
During literacy, select a page and see if it has any words that start with a specific letter or sound.
