Just a gentle reminder that Mother Teresa School, as is the case with most schools, has a dress code that applies to all staff and students (School Handbook - See school website).

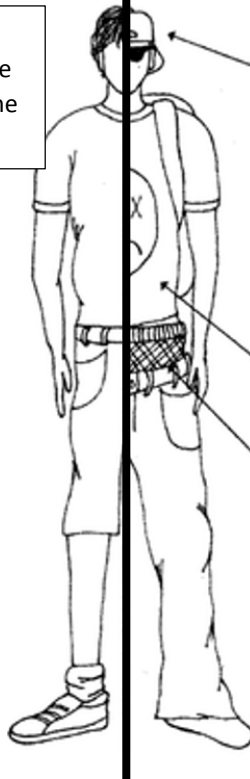
We hope that the information below will serve as a useful guide in helping you and your child make their daily clothing choices.

Acceptable  
at Mother

Hats, coats and  
backpacks are to be  
stored outside of the  
classroom



Unacceptable  
at Mother Teresa School

Hats, scarves, bandanas, hoodies or  
other head coverings may not be worn  
in the school except for medical or  
religious reasons.

No tops with spaghetti straps (strap  
minimum is 2" wide), no halter-tops or  
articles of clothing showing cleavage.

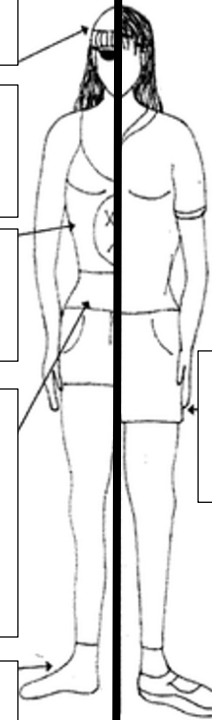
No shirts with inappropriate or  
degrading graphics or wording.

Students must  
not be showing  
underwear.

Undergarments,  
including bra  
straps, stomachs  
(belly buttons)  
should be  
covered.

No barefeet or stocking feet. Students  
must wear indoor shoes while inside of  
the school.

If worn, skirts and shorts must be at  
or below fingertip length when a  
student's arm is placed at her side.

If leggings are worn, a  
top must also be worn  
that is at or below  
fingertip length when a  
student's arm is placed at  
her side.
