First Day of School – September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019

- Grade 7 students will come for the full day at 7:45 am for a pancake breakfast.
- The grade 8's and 9's will join us after lunch at 12:25 pm. All grades will be dismissed at 3:01 pm.
