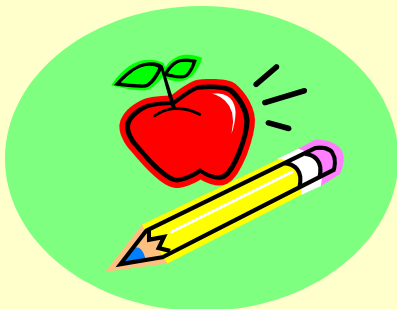

Curriculum update 2D

Term 1

English

- Expresses ideas and opinions to connect and build understanding
- Asks questions and/or considers others' ideas to clarify and extend understanding
- Identifies high frequency words by sight
- Uses spelling strategies correctly in own writing
- Writes legibly with attention to form and spacing

Science

- Describes the properties of magnets and understands how they are used
- Identifies uses of magnets in the environment
- Predicts whether or not an object will be attracted by a magnet
- Designs and builds a device that uses magnets

Social

- Determines distance on a map using terms such as near/far, here/there
- Uses simple maps to locate communities studied in Canada
- Understands the differences in the geography of an Inuit, Acadian and/or prairie community in Canada
- Uses cardinal directions (North, South, East, West) to locate communities studied

Religion

- Demonstrates an understanding that there are many ways to pray
- Demonstrates an understanding that the Beatitudes teach us how to live and show love like Jesus
- Demonstrates an understanding that the Mass, especially the Eucharist, is a celebration of Jesus' love
- Demonstrates an understanding that the Church is a community that gathers to worship and celebrate the Eucharist
