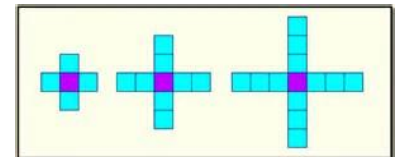
Spanish: We will learn about some of the Mexican culture. Students will do non-fiction writing as well on autumn and bats.
