

## OVERVIEW

ETS has updated the School Special bus route numbering system. The majority of School Special bus routes will now operate as a branch of a regular ETS route.

For simplicity, we recommend that students/parents/schools use one of the two trip-planning options below.

**ETS has updated the School Special bus route numbering system. The majority of School Special bus routes will now operate as a branch of a regular ETS route.**

**Important:** on the front of buses, destination signs will include an “S” next to route number and the name of the final school that bus route services. Some School Special routes service multiple schools.

**Option 1:** Use Google Maps or Transit App.

- You will be provided with several trip options on both regular ETS and School Special bus routes. In Transit App, school bus routes will show the letter “S” after the route number. In Google Maps the letter “S” will appear next to route numbers after you expand the details of each trip option.
- When planning trips before the start of school term, be sure to adjust your dates to the first week of September in the trip planning fields.

**Option 2:** Use the ETS School Service Trip Planner: <http://etstriplanner.edmonton.ca/SchoolService.aspx>

- You will see all bus routes that operate near your selected school. These routes will be a mix of regular ETS routes and new School Specials. Note: You will not see the letter “S” next to school route numbers when using this particular trip-planning tool.
  - Clicking each route will bring up all map variations for that route. Please scroll down until you find the correct map for your school.
