KINDERGARTEN / 100 VOICES REGISTRATIONS 2018 - 2019 SCHOOL YEAR

Registrations are now being accepted for the 2018-2019 school year. To attend our full day Kindergarten Program, children must live within the school boundary and be 5 years old before March 1, 2019.

The **First Reconciliation Preparation Program** is for baptized children, age 7 and up, to prepare them to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession).

Children must receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before beginning Preparation for First Communion.

- There is a fee of \$15/child to cover the cost of the child's workbook. Please bring this payment to the first class
- Classes will take place on Saturday mornings from 10:00 - 11:00am, October 6 - November 3 at St. Alphonsus Parish (11828 - 85 St. NW)
- Celebration of First Reconciliation will take place on November 10 at 10:00am at St. Alphonsus Parish

Each child must attend all classes with a parent/guardian and complete all workbook assignments in order to be eligible to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

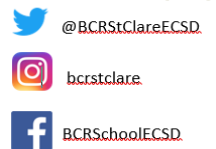
