Please note that with this new program there will be a print progress report available for each student on January 31st; this November, we will invite you to witness and follow your child's daily progress through PowerSchool, a secure website that allows students and parents access to student attendance records, grades, school fees, and other information.

Our Grade 4A class is so excited to meet their goal of 800 items for the food bank. They have already collected over 200 items from their class alone! If you would like to donate a can with your child, please send that along to the office before November 30th.
