

School Start Up: 2019-20

Cardinal Léger will be having a staggered entry for students on **Tuesday, September 3, 2019**.

The schedule is as follows:

Grade 7 Students: 8:15pm – 11:47pm

Grade 7 student registration will begin at 8:15am and they will be dismissed for the day at 11:47am. Students will be assigned to their classes, meet their homeroom teachers and receive their schedules and textbooks. All students will also receive their locks and lockers on this day.

Grade 8 & 9 Students: 12:27pm – 2:58pm

Grade 8 & 9 student registration will begin at 12:27pm and they will be dismissed at 2:58pm. Students will be assigned to their classes and receive their schedules and textbooks. All students will also receive their locks and lockers on this day.

Please note that the ETS School Specials (buses) are scheduled to run on this day, but there will be no school special available at lunch.

PAYMENT OF ALL MONIES

For the 2019-20 school year, all payments (field trips, option costs, supplementary fees, extra-curricular activities, bus passes) must be paid online through the students PowerSchool account. If you are unable to make payments through PowerSchool, you will have the option of coming to the school and paying with either Debit or Visa/Mastercard. **Cheques will no longer be accepted for any payments.** If you need to make payment by cash, we ask that you contact **Mrs. Fabiano** in the office to make alternate arrangements.

All option fees and supplementary fees will be processed once all students are confirmed in their options. Invoices will be **available online on September 12th and are due by September 30, 2019**. The school will send home an email reminder once invoices have been posted to PowerSchool.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Locks will be provided by the school for all student lockers; locks must be returned to the school at the end of the year. Students who do not return locks at the end of the year will be expected to pay the replacement cost.
- Physical education clothing is mandatory for all students during physical education. Each student must have shorts or sweatpants, a t-shirt, and running shoes. They may bring their own from home, or they may purchase shorts and t-shirts directly from the school. We will also be introducing an online store in the Fall where students will be able to order items directly. If planning to purchase from the school, please note that items will not be released until payment is received.
- Students may be asked to purchase additional supplies depending upon their options or additional program needs throughout the year.
