- Students can be registered in PASS and in another High School.
- Students cannot be enrolled in the same course at the same time in two different schools. (This means students cannot simultaneously take a course at their high school and at PASS).
- Students must have the prerequisite for any course they wish to enroll in.
- Students in grade 9 of the current school year are not permitted to enroll in PASS courses.
- Teachers will advise students and keep them informed of their progress on a regular basis. Frequent communication in person, by phone or by email is highly encouraged.
- Students must be on-site for all summative assessment and must be in contact with their teacher once a week.

OUR LADY OF GRACE

Our Lady of Grace provides mobile and individualized services for pregnant or parenting teens (female and male). The program provides assistance to students within their community school, where educational alternatives are available in a regular school setting. Our staff, which consists of Social Workers and Psychologists, assesses every student to see what her or his needs are, and services are provided based on those needs. Personalized counseling for students and their families is available, complimented by weekly parent support groups, pre-natal and post-natal courses and referrals to community agencies.

NEW: MILL WOODS CAMPUS

Cardinal Collins High School Academic Centres offer an academic upgrading program for 4th and 5th year high school students. The Centres offer an adult learning environment that focuses on high school completion and/or upgrading diploma course marks. All 30 level diploma courses are offered in the classroom and are timetabled in a quarterly structure around the November, January, April and June diploma writes. In an intensive 8 week quarter program, students are able to complete one or two diploma courses and write the diploma exam at the end of the quarter. Students can enroll in either a morning class or afternoon class. Academic counseling is offered to all students preparing them for post-secondary transition or career exploration.

A Cardinal Collins student:

- Has attended a regular high school for three years
- Is 19 years of age or under on September 1st of the school year you are planning to attend
- Is focused and motivated to meet their post-secondary and career goals
- Is working on the course for the first time or repeating course work

If the registration cannot be accommodated at another location, a full refund will be issued for any course cancelled by Alternative Education. Refunds can take up to four weeks to process. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



▶ **If I am 20 and under, can I take a course with Alternative Education?**

- If you are 20 years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year, you can take a course with Alternative Education. See page 6 for fees
- You will need to prove completion of the prerequisite course by providing your Alberta Student Number (ASN)
- If you are not currently registered in school, you can still take an Alternative Education course
- Students cannot be registered in the same course at the same time at two different locations
- You must have completed Grade 9 to take any high school level course

▶ **If I am not an Edmonton Catholic School District (ECSD) student could I take a course with Alternative Education? How can I ensure my registration is complete?**

- Registration is open to all students
- Students will be required to complete an additional ECSD registration form as well as provide legal documentation such as a Canadian Birth Certificate, Canadian Passport, Permanent Resident Card etc. A driver's licence is not considered sufficient documentation
- Please call Alternative Education at 780 944-2000 for more information

▶ **What is a Prerequisite? Is it required?**

- Prerequisite courses are courses required to be completed prior to entering the next level
- Alberta Education states that a student who has achieved a mark of 50% or higher in a given course is eligible to take the next or high-ranking high school course in that sequence

▶ **If I'm an International Student in Canada with a study permit, can I take a course with Alternative Education?**

- Eligible international students may take Alternative Education courses and must provide their valid student study permit, passport and current school records to determine eligibility for admission

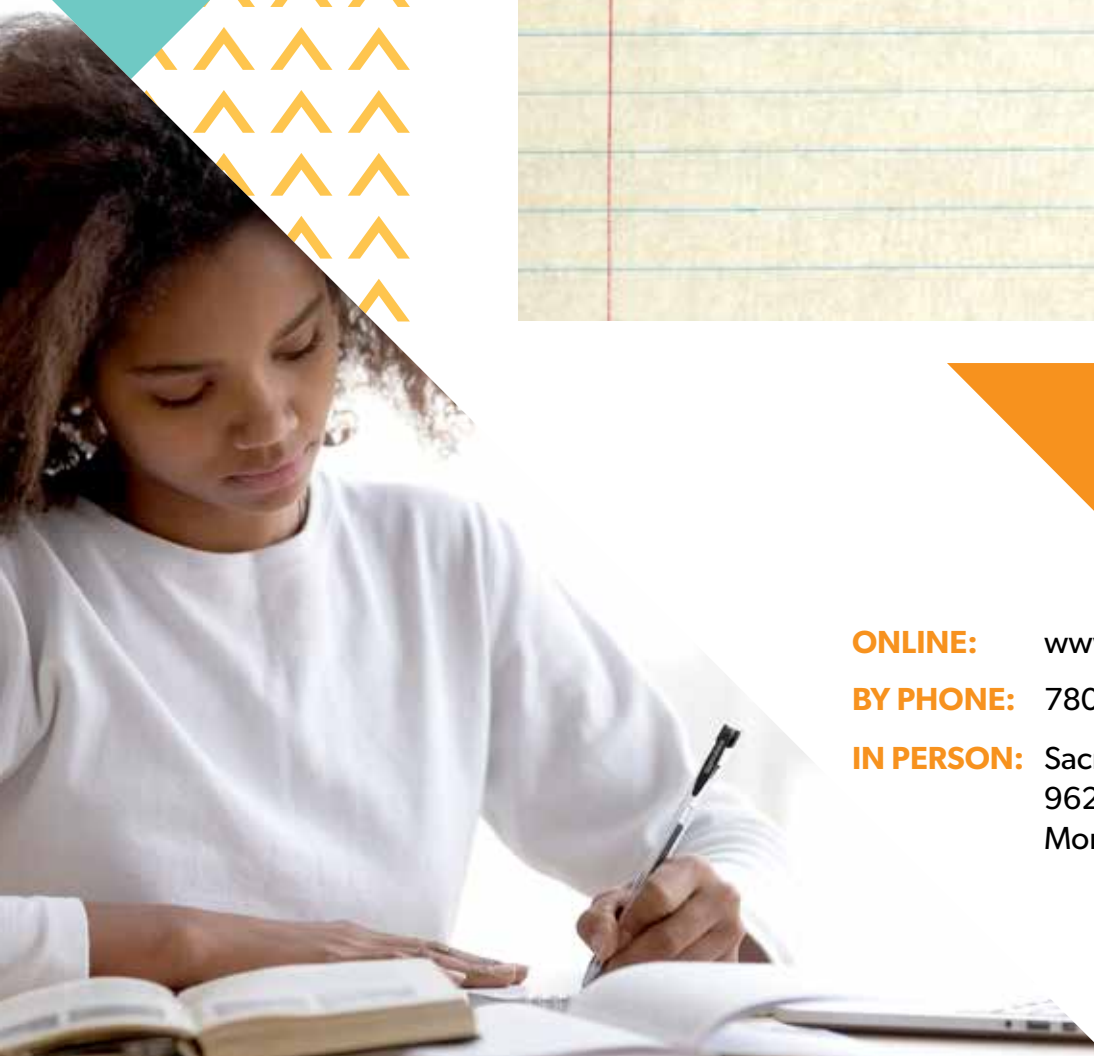
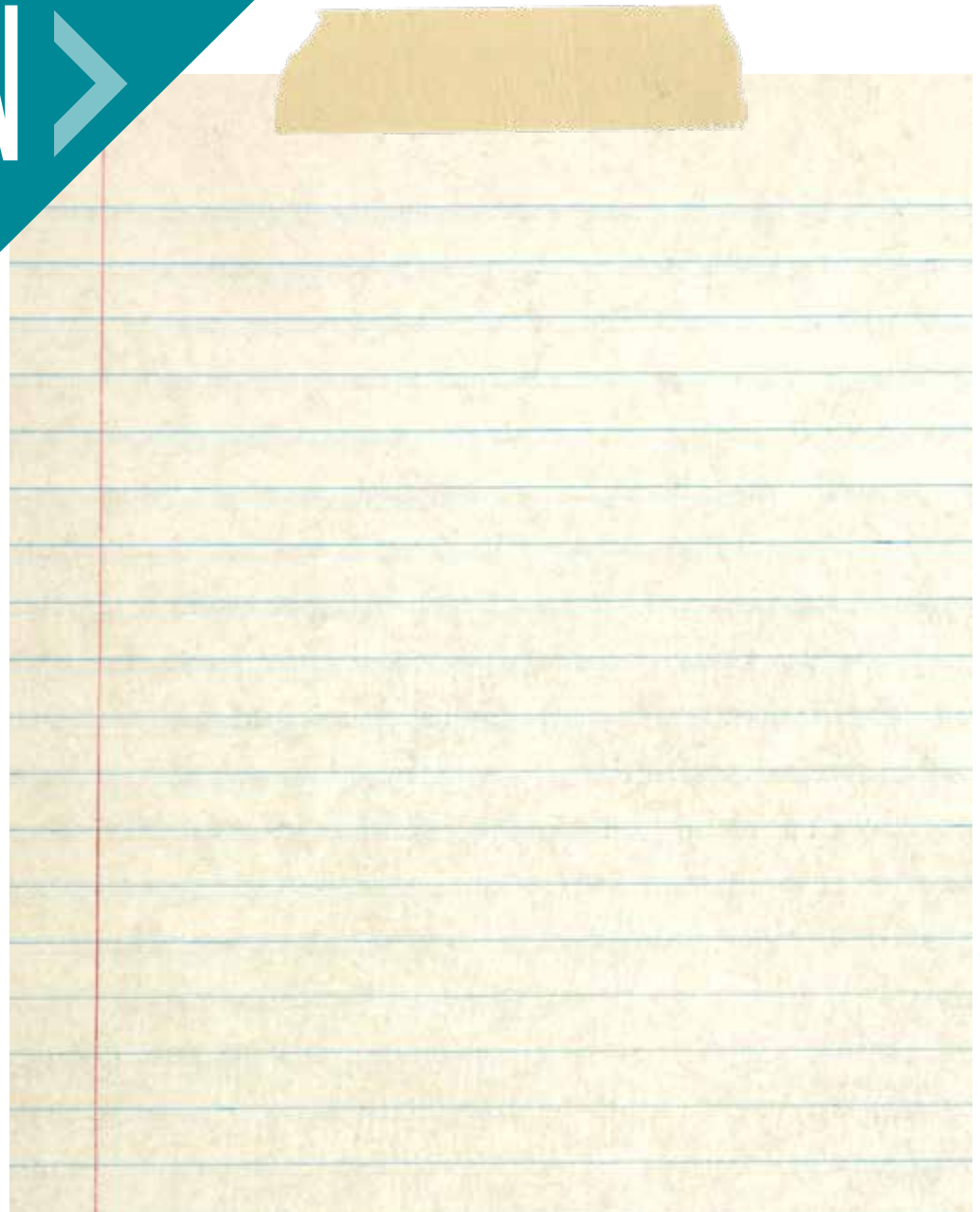
▶ **Where can I obtain my Detailed Academic Report (DAR)?**
