What do the stories of Indigenous youth reveal about youth-adult relationships in high school settings?

A research study exploring the lived experience of youth-adult relationships among Indigenous youth attending high schools in the Edmonton metropolitan area is being undertaken. The study seeks the participation of individuals, 18 to 21 years old, who self-identify as First Nation, Métis or Inuit and are attending or have attended a metropolitan Edmonton area high school within the last five years. If you agree to participate in this study, you will be asked to:

- Give informed consent by signing a consent form; you will be given a copy of this form.
- Participate in one of two sharing circle/focus group addressing four questions. The sharing circle/focus group discussions will be audio recorded to ensure that what you say is accurately recorded;
- You may be invited to participate in an individual interview to expand upon statements made in the sharing circle/focus group.
