

I further authorise the archdiocesan office/parish/camp/organization to use or publish any such images or recordings in its sole discretion.

I understand that my child/youth shall be required to abide by all of the rules of the overnight event, which will be provided to him/her and that my youth's failure to follow these rules may result in my child's immediate dismissal from the overnight event at my expense.
